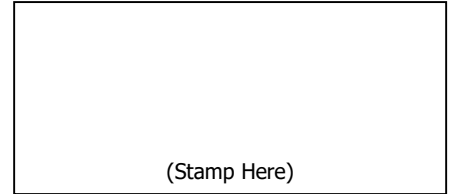

LMRG Highlights:

- Planning, design, and construction of the new LE&I are in full swing at our new south London location.
- The LE&I is a 2-rail, O-scale (1:48) railroad, inspired by Port Stanley, London, and environs as they might have been in the 1970s.
- Multiple development phases are planned, with two main levels and approximately 500' feet of track in the initial phase, including a 12' diameter helix.
- The new LE&I will be fully digital, using DCC, JMRI, and Arduino technologies for train and track control, as well as automation, animation and lighting.
